The amount of the sanitary conditions-functional toilets and taps in urban areas of Kancheepuram is very limited. So Maatram Educational and Charitable Trust want to make the utmost efforts to complete a sanitation project that will enhance hygiene for the residents. Great efforts have been made to redress desperate living conditions of that village containing around 100 families. There is sub-standard structural quality of housing which does not withstand heavy winds or rain. Our focus is to improve these living conditions accompanied with an education system for the children around.

We have also managed to provide everyone in that village with food and distribution of clothes with the help of our volunteers. Traditional clothes - Sarees were given to women, shirts/dhotis to men, T-Shirts and pants to youngsters and biscuits and dresses to kids.
